CLUB RULES

The Pine Lake Country Club is a private club and is for the use of its members and their guests.

SECTION I

1. Metal spikes are prohibited at all times.
2. Riding carts are to remain on the Cart Paths where available.
3. Winter golf rule (players are allowed to improve their lie within 6 inches, but no closer to the hole) always applies at the club unless the person running a particular event states otherwise.
4. Shirts or blouses and shoes are required on the course and in the clubhouse at all times.
5. The course is closed to snowmobiling.

SECTION II

Members are entitled to bring guests to the club according to the following rules and regulations.

1. Members are encouraged to bring guests to the clubhouse or golf course to introduce them to the facilities. Such guests will be entitled to a \$2.00 reduction from the established Green Fees when they play golf with a member.
2. Unmarried members may have a guest at the clubhouse.
3. Any resident of Eldora may be the guest of a member once each year for one round of golf.

SECTION III

Rental of the Clubhouse or Golf Course for private functions.

1. All club facilities are open to all members at all times, and no member or organization may have exclusive use of the same.

2. Local organizations whose membership includes some members of the club may hold noon luncheons at the clubhouse, except for Sundays.
3. **Grill Rental policy** - The grill is for use of members at no extra charge. Each member may have one non-member as a guest in using the grill at no charge. When a group made up of more non-members, there will be a \$ 25 charge. The grill cannot be used to sell food in competition with the clubhouse. *The patio is for use of all club members, and cannot be reserved without renting the clubhouse.*
4. All arrangements for meetings or entertainment for groups **MUST** be made with the club manager. Call 641-858-3031.
- 5 **Clubhouse rental:**
Upstairs: \$150– To Members
 \$350 – To Non-Members
A deposit of \$75 is required before rental of the clubhouse facilities. The deposit is refundable if the clubhouse facilities are left clean, undamaged, and all property returned to the original areas. This is to be determined by the club manager.
6. **Course rental:** \$600.00 + tax– ½ day course closed

**Closing of the course for private functions is available on Sunday, Monday, Thursday and Fridays.
Times are: 7 to 1 p.m. or 2 p.m. to close.**

SECTION IV

Members should direct any complaints to the Board in writing.

All written complaints will be answered and appropriate action taken as deemed necessary by the Board of Directors. Please **DO NOT** discuss complaints with a board member in public settings or during play.

Complaints are **NOT** to be directed to **ANY** employee, at any time. The Board of Directors meet the third Monday of each month at the clubhouse.

SECTION V

All dues must be paid in full by May 1st, 2011 or installments of one-half by March 31st, 2011 with the balance due by May 31, 2011 or arrangements for monthly payments.

*Out of Town Members must belong to another Iowa Golf Association Member Club and live at least 5 miles from the Courthouse Square.

*Entitled to four 9-Hole rounds of golf per membership, per year.

Social Membership---\$150.00 (w/ tax--\$160.50)

Electric---\$120.00 (w/ tax-- \$128.40)

Gas-----\$90.00 (w/ tax-- \$96.30)

Trail Fees---\$35.00 (\$37.45 w/ tax) per year for Members

Special Events:

Non-members, participating in a club sponsored special event (i.e. Thursday Night Two-Ball and Men's Special Stags) will be charged a \$5.00 green fee, per person, in addition to the normal entry fee charged to Club members.

Use of PLCC beverage coolers will require a refundable deposit upon return of \$ 5.00.

The use of debit or credit cards in the clubhouse will require a minimum charge. of \$ 5.00.

2011 MEN'S SPECIAL STAGS

In addition to the fees for the meal & stag events, guests will be required to pay \$5.00 in green fees to the club.

2011 PLCC LADIES ASSOCIATION

Wednesday Ladies meals will be \$ 5.00 unless otherwise announced as a catered meal or potluck. The first person listed on each committee will be in charge.

FRIDAY NIGHT COCKTAIL PARTY COMMITTEES

The first person or couple listed for a cocktail party will be in charge of the committee. If you are listed for a Friday Night event and you are unable to Host, you should line up a couple to take your place. If you need assistance, please contact the Clubhouse Manager at 858-3031. Unless otherwise noted, the Cocktail parties will begin at 5:30 pm and usually last a couple of hours. Each couple on the committee should bring an hors d'oeuvre. If you have suggestions for other social activities, please feel free to let the club manager know.

COUPLES TWO BALL COMMITTEES

The first couple listed for a two-ball event will be in charge of the committee.

Members are reminded that they may invite a couple to be a guest for Two-Ball once a season. In addition to the normal entry fee, non-member couples will be charged the special events \$5.00 green fee, per person, to participate in the Two-Ball event. Single non-members, playing as a partner of a member, will also be charged the \$5.00 green fee.

***This is a catered meal.** Committee's are responsible for; setting up the Two-ball event, table set-up for catered meal, and serving the meal. The caterer will clean-up. **Committee members that choose to eat must pay for their meal, in addition you may pay and play in the two-ball if you choose to.**

Must be signed up to play and or eat by noon on Wednesday.

PLEASE NOTE: If you cannot fulfill your committee duties, please make arrangements with the rest of the committee and/or arrange for a replacement.

Ladies Golf Events

Guess Your Score - Money awarded to one who comes closest to guessed score noted next to your name on sign in sheet. Turn in your score card. (9holes)

Crier's Night - Throw out two worst holes and revert them to par.

Odd & Even - Play with a partner. One partner hits on even shots and the other the odd shots. Add handicaps together and divide by 2 to get team handicap. Use this handicap and subtract from your score to get team score.

Mutt & Jeff - Play all 9 holes, but only longest and shortest holes count. Half of your handicap will be used. Add strokes for number 1,4,7 and 8 and put this total on your scorecard.

Colored Tee - Color of tee drawn indicates your team. Lowest net score team wins.

Four Gal Best Shot - Team members will be drawn. The person who makes the last shot will not be able to participate in the next shot. (ie: Final putter would be out for next drive)

Garbage - Regular golf - a chart will be supplied to determine number of points you score (hitting a tree, four putt, etc.)

Modified Stableford - Regular golf—a chart will be supplied to figure your score based on pars, bogeys, etc.

T's,S's,&P's - Keep track of your score on holes 2,3,6, and 7. Half your handicap will be used.

Kicker's Relay - You can replay any two shots in your round. You must use your replay ball & not your first.

Longest Putt - Regular golf - Signs will be placed at given greens to establish longest putt.

I Play Again - Divided your handicap in half and replay that number of shots in a round. You must use the 2nd shot. Do not turn in for handicap round.

2 Week Eclectic - A mini “ringer” tourney. First week keep actual score (keep your scorecard). The next week you can change any score if it is better—use a third scorecard to turn in.

TYPS - Take Your Partners Shot” - You may use two of your partners shots and she may use two of yours. Do not use handicap.

Blind Partner Relay - After the day's play you will be paired with a partner. One partner's score will count for holes 1-5, the other's for 6-9. Partner's handicap will be added together and a percentage of that used to compute a 9 hole score.

Ringer Tournament - All season. If you better your original score on a hole during regular Wednesday play (Ladies Day Only), change it on the board.

Ladies Day Meals - \$5.00 each (Catered meal prices to be announced)

The Women's Golf Association is governed by the USGA rules and the general rules of the Pine Lake Country Club. We are members in good standing of IWGA and District Nine.

We will be using handicaps on Women's Day. The handicap sheet will be posted on the bulletin board in the women's restroom downstairs. After EACH round of golf (whether Wednesday or any other time), record your score after your name. Handicaps will be calculated on a weekly basis or at least bi-monthly basis. You need to turn in a least 3 rounds of scores to get a handicap.
